President George W. Bush today announced his intention to nominate nine individuals to serve in his Administration.

The President intends to nominate Neel T. Kashkari, of California, to be Assistant Secretary of the Treasury (International Affairs). Mr. Kashkari recently served as Senior Advisor to the Secretary at the Department of the Treasury. Prior to this, he served as Vice President of Goldman, Sachs & Co. Earlier in his career, he served as a Research and Development Principal Investigator at TRW. Mr. Kashkari received his bachelor's degree and master's degree from the University of Illinois. He received his MBA from the University of Pennsylvania.

Neel Kashkari is Senior Advisor to U.S. Treasury Secretary Henry M. Paulson, Jr. He provides counsel to the Secretary on key policy matters.

Prior to joining the Treasury Department, Mr. Kashkari was a Vice President at Goldman, Sachs & Co. in San Francisco, where he led Goldman's IT Security Investment Banking practice, advising public and private companies on mergers and acquisitions and financial transactions. Prior to his career in finance, Mr. Kashkari was a R&D Principal Investigator at TRW in Redondo Beach, California where he developed technology for NASA space science missions such as the James Webb Space Telescope.

Originally from Stow, Ohio, Mr. Kashkari graduated from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign with B.A. and M.A. degrees in engineering. He also received an M.B.A. in finance from the Wharton School. Mr. Kashkari and his wife Minal maintain residences in Maryland and California.
